

Ring Sizes

The best way to find your ring size is to visit a professional jeweller. He will measure your finger using a set of steel rings and he will assist you in determining which size is more comfortable for you.

Jootiq is using the ISO 8653:1986 standard for ring sizes, which defines ring sizes in terms of the inner circumference of the ring measured in millimetres. You can use table 1 if you already know your size in a different standard. It might be safer to pick the larger size if you are between sizes but it is a personal choice.

Bear in mind that there are many factors, that affect your finger size over the day or over periods of time. Menstrual cycle, exercise, humidity and temperature, some medication to name a few. Also be aware for fingers with large knuckles. A size that is comfortable may not slide through. Wider band rings can be worn more loosely.

That being said you should know that one size to the next is still very close.

If you already have a ring which is a symmetrical shape like a wedding band, align it with a matching circle on table 2 and read your size using one eye. Pay extra attention to match exactly where the black circles begin.

Be aware:

- Using charts found on the net that give size equivalents is not always correct because different sizes do not correspond precisely with each other. And all sizes are not available. You can understand this by looking at table 1.
- Using sizers that you print yourself and cutout is highly inaccurate. We recommend you do not count on finding your size this way.
- Using plastic gauges has some accuracy but we found that one size off is pretty common.

The safest method to find your ring size is visiting a professional jeweler and it is also our recommendation.
